MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF  
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for petitioner respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for petitioner respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel will file the brief of petitioner in the case of Jalen T. Badger v. State with the Court of Appeals today, September 12, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of State v. Derrick Joseph Miles with the Court of Appeals on August 25, 2022. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant in the case of State v. Orlando Reames with the Court of Appeals on August 4, 2022. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant in the case of State v. Kelcie Ralph Gilbert with the Court of Appeals on July 15, 2022. Counsel filed the Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Aikeem Lott v. State with the Supreme Court on July 11, 2022. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the interest of Jaylin S., a juvenile under the age of seventeen, with the Court of Appeals on June 6, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, has graciously consented to this extension request by way of the thirty-day general consent granted by email from Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka dated August 31, 2022 for all Appellate Defense extensions through September 30, 2022.


