## ORDER

Appellant appeals an order of the Administrative Law Court (ALC) dismissing his appeal for failing to file his brief. Because Appellant has failed to meet his burden to identify any state-created liberty or property interest involved in failing to comply with the ALC's procedures, the motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is denied. *See Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995) ("In the absence of a statutory provision allowing the general waiver of filing fees, we conclude motions to proceed in forma pauperis may only be granted where specifically authorized by statute or required by constitutional provisions."). Accordingly, the filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order.
