**ORDER DENYING DEFENDANT’S  
MOTIONS (1) SET ASIDE JUDGMENT,  
(2) FOR RELIEF FROM JUDGMENT,  
(3) TO SET ASIDE DEFAULT, and  
(4) TO RECONSIDER THE JUDGMENT  
RENDERED ON JULY 14, 2022**

This matter comes before me upon Motions of Defendant (1) to set aside an order for judgment issued by this Court on July 14, 2022, pursuant to Rule 60(b), SCRPC, (2) for relief from said Judgment pursuant to Rules 52 and 59, SCRPC, (3) to set aside the Default entered against Defendant, and (4) to reconsider this Court’s ruling entering the Order for Judgment.

The Defendant was found in default and the matter was referred to me, as Master in Equity, by that Order of Reference signed by the Honorable Steven H. John, Resident Circuit Judge, on June 3, 2022. Thereafter, after due notice of the hearing was provided to the Defendant, the undersigned conducted a damages hearing on July 14, 2022 and subsequently filed the Order for Partial Judgment, Delivery of Assets and Full Accounting Disclosure on July 14, 2022.

Appearing for Defendant was Thomas W. Winslow and for the Plaintiffs, John M. Leiter, Natalie Stevens-Graziani, and James P. Stevens, Jr. The Plaintiffs and the Defendant were also present.

Other than the four Motions filed by Defendant, the Defendant did not file any affidavits, documents or memorandum of law. The Plaintiffs filed their Memorandum of Law in Opposition to Defendant’s motions along with affidavits and other documents supporting their position.

After due consideration of the able arguments of counsel for both sides, I find that the Defendant has failed to carry his burden of proof for relief from the Order for Partial Judgment, Delivery of Assets, and Full Accounting Disclosure and his Motions as set forth above should be denied.

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that the Defendant’s Motions as above set forth is hereby denied.
