

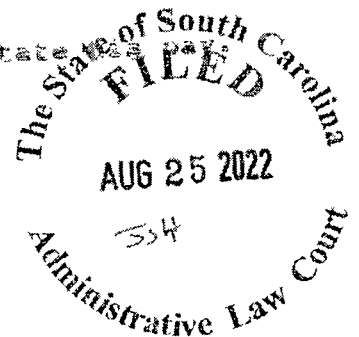
CONCLUSION




