MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

The State in this Court on September 7, 2022 Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Randy D. Marchbanks with the Court of Appeals on August 25, 2022. Counsel was in attendance at the 2022 American Bar Association Annual Meeting in Chicago, Illinois as one of the representatives of the South Carolina Bar Young Lawyers Division from August 4, 2022 through August 7, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Justin Bradley v. The State with this Court on August 3, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of William Coleman v. The State with this Court on August 1, 2022.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty (30) day
