3.) It is the Appellant's burden to ensure that a sufficient record is provided.

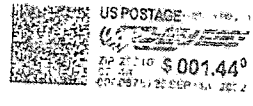
I, Earl Rafel Gaddis, Jr., certify that the supplemental record will contain no matter which is irrelevant to this appeal.
