
THIS MATTER ORIGINALLY CAME BEFORE THE COURT on April 18, 2022 on a Community Supervision violation. Mr. Booker raised several arguments as to why his placement on Community Supervision violated state and federal law, and the Court was informed that, but for his failing to pay his supervision fees, Mr. Booker was fully compliant with all the terms and conditions of his supervision. The Court issued an order dated April 28, 2022 finding that Mr. Booker's placement on Community Supervision complied with all applicable laws and ordering that he deposit the supervision fees owed with the Clerk of Court pending an anticipated appeal which has been filed. The Court was subsequently informed that Mr. Booker had not deposited the fees with the Clerk, and the Court ordered that a hearing be reconvened on August 15, 2022.

At the August 15th hearing, Mr. Booker again appeared *pro se*, and the Department of Probation, Pardon, and Parole was represented by Jessica Kinard, Esq. Mr. Booker made additional arguments as to why his being placed on Community Supervision violated the law, and the Court again found that his participation in that program comported with all applicable state and federal law. The Court again reiterated the requirement that he deposit his supervision fees with the Clerk pending his appeal and gave Mr. Booker until the end of the week to do so.

The Court was subsequently informed that Mr. Booker deposited his pending fees in the sum of

\$1,050.00 with the Clerk. Accordingly, the Court orders that Mr. Booker be released from Community Supervision, but his release from supervision shall not, of course, affect the justiciability of his underlying appeal.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
