PETITIONER'S MOTION TO
RECONSIDER AND TO ALTER
OR AMEND JUDGMENT

Petitioner, Alonzo C. Jeter, III, hereby respectfully motions this Court that it would Reconsider and Alter or Amend its Judgment rendered in this case. This Court made its order on September 14, 2022, denying Petitioner's motions and dismissing this case. Petitioner received notice of this dismissal on September 19, 2022, by and through the Manning Correctional Institution Legal Mail System.

Petitioner files this motion in the interest of certainty and clarity as the Court's order is unclear and does not reflect and address the following regards:

1. The Court's order does not reflect and make for certain that it basis its denial on the contents of Petitioner's two-part explanation, and acknowledging Petitioner's motion to strike.

Specifically, Petitioner filed his original Explanation on June 6, 2022. Petitioner then filed a Supplemental/Amended Explanation on July 28, 2022, which contained references to the Appendices I and II which were filed simultaneously on the same date of July 28, 2022.

Next, on September 9, 2022, Petitioner mailed to this Court for filing, a PART II to his Supplemental/Amended Explanation along with a Motion to Strike. In the Motion to Strike, Petitioner requests this Court that it would strike Petitioner's original Explanation which was filed on June 6, 2022; and therefore consider and adjudicate upon the July 28, 2022 Explanation and the PART II Explanation as one consolidated Explanation.

The Court's Order does not specifically indicate that it considered these filings as Petitioner's Explanation ~~and Petitioner~~, as the filings were mailed on September 9, 2022 and the order dismissing the case was signed on September 14, 2022, would not assume that this Court had the time and opportunity to review these filings along with Petitioner's exhibit proof provided in the Appendices I, II, and Supplemental to Appendix II, in such a short window of time.

2. Petitioner filed a Motion For Assistance In Acquiring Transcript, on June 2, 2022. In this motion Petitioner requests this Court provide assistance in funding for and to acquire the transcript of the Rule 59(e), SCRPC, hearing which was convened in the lower court on March 31, 2022, before the Honorable J. Derham Cole.

Petitioner did also obtain the costs associated with acquiring a copy of this transcript and did file a copy of this costs correspondence with this Court on June 27, 2022.

3. Petitioner filed on July 27, 2022, a Motion For Assistance In Acquiring Certified Transcription of Audio Recordings. In this motion Petitioner requested that this Court would assist Petitioner in obtaining a certified written or transcribed copy of the Audio Deposition of Petitioner's South Carolina Department of Corrections Annual Review and Classification Hearing proceedings.

Petitioner would make clear to this Court that he does in fact have a copy of this Audio Deposition on a Compact Disc (CD), and requests that this Court at the very least allow Petitioner to provide this Court with a copy of this Audio deposition. Petitioner did attempt to provide the same to the lower court, however, the lower court returned the same to Petitioner stating that he would be allowed to present this at a future hearing in the case. CONCLUSION

Petitioner prays this Court would reconsider and alter or amend its judgment in these regards by accepting and acknowledging Petitioner's filings, providing impartial adjudication and consideration with regard to the same, and providing the assistance requested with regard to the transcripts which Petitioner has brought to this Court's attention.
