CONSENT MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF AND  
DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Appellant, with the consent of Respondent, respectfully moves this Court to extend the time for filing the initial brief and designation of matter by 30 days.

The transcript in this matter was received Friday, September 2, 2022. On Wednesday, September 7, 2022, counsel started a murder trial (*United States v. Dominique Brand*) in the Florence Division of the United States District Court. The trial did not conclude until Wednesday, September 14. Additionally, counsel recently received the Appellant's brief in the matter of *Owens, et al. v. Stirling, et al*, a challenge to the death penalty methods of execution in which the Supreme Court has ordered no extensions will be granted.

Based on these matters and other work, counsel will not complete the brief in the instant appeal by the deadline of October 3. Counsel believes, based on the important appellate rights at stake in this case and the lack of prejudice to either party from this short delay, this is a reasonable request.

Counsel respectfully requests the Court grant a 30-day extension in this case, resulting in a deadline of November 2, 2022. Counsel has discussed this request with opposing counsel, and he consents to the request.
