ORDER

After careful consideration, Appellant's motion for appointment of counsel is denied. *See Baxter v. Palmigiano*, 425 U.S. 308, 315 (1976) (holding prison inmates do not have a right to either retained or appointed counsel in disciplinary hearings). Appellant's motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is also denied. *See Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 535, 471 S.E.2d 134, 134-35 (1995) ("In the absence of a statutory provision allowing the general waiver of filing fees, we conclude motions to proceed in forma pauperis may only be granted where specifically authorized by statute or required by constitutional provisions."). The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order.
