ORDER

After careful consideration, Appellant's motion to amend the record on appeal is granted in part and denied in part. Within twenty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall file an amended record on appeal that replaces the transcript of Dr. Scheild Wikas's June 28, 2019 deposition with the transcript of Dr. Wikas's June 21, 2021 deposition. Appellant's request to include additional, unspecified excerpts from the June 28, 2019 deposition is denied. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record shall not, however, include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal."). Respondents shall file their final brief within twenty days of Appellant's service and filing of the amended record on appeal.
