I had acknowledged your note and receipt of the Order yesterday regarding the Brief. After I had re-read the Motion Respondent's attorney had submitted, and then the wording of the Order about me needing to file "a proper initial brief", I was upset. I had made the corrections in form requested earlier via Claire's note, and also received back the items of Matter I had included with the Initial Brief with instructions to return them at the proper time.

My father died four years ago this November and this suit filed by me in Probate Court has gone on almost that long. The Truluck firm was retained by Respondent, Three lawyers in that firm have been and are still being paid by Respondent using my Dad's money. I used up my savings to pay lawyers and then had to go pro se. I was told by the Greenville Lawyer Referral Service that there was too much money in my father's estate for me to retain a pro bono attorney, and that "maybe I could hold a garage sale". There have been too many errors on the part of Respondent's attorneys to list, some of which have been ignored, but some addressed by the courts. I believe this latest attempt to have my Appeal dismissed because of supposed lack of proper content, failure to properly file or serve, irrelevant facts, etc. is just another delay tactic to run up fees and to avoid an audit and independent administrator for the two Trusts in dispute. I never asked for Respondent to be removed as Trustee, and have only asked for a full accounting to which I am entitled by S. Carolina law of the two Trusts of which I was Co-Trustee and am still beneficiary. I have two file boxes full of paperwork, including receipts for court filings and fees, including proofs of service to all parties involved in all three courts.

I understand that I have 30 days to file an emended Initial Brief, which would be by November 1, 2022. The content will not be changed or edited, as the documented facts remain the same, and all are pertinent. Please advise. A call or E-Mail will be greatly appreciated.

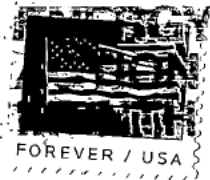
