ORDER

This appeal arises out of an order of the circuit court denying Appellant's motion to dismiss based on immunity under the Protection of Persons and Property Act¹ (the Act). Because the underlying order is not immediately appealable, the appeal is dismissed. *See State v. Isaac*, 405 S.C. 177, 182, 747 S.E.2d 677, 679 (2013) (holding the denial of a request for immunity under the Act is not a final order, and thus not immediately appealable). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
