
INDICTMENT FOR  
Unlawful Conduct Towards a Child

§ 63-05-0070

At a Court of General Sessions, convened in September of 2022, the Grand Jurors of Lexington County present upon their oath:

That Collin Reyes Stevens in Lexington County, South Carolina, on or about April 21, 2022, while having charge or custody, or being the parent or guardian, or being responsible for the welfare of the minor child, V. Stevens, unlawfully, place the child at unreasonable risk of harm affecting the child's life, physical or mental health, or safety, to wit: the defendant did have his daughter in close proximity to illegal narcotics, defined in 63-7-20 and in violation of Section 63-5-70 South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.
