MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel respectfully requests a **final extension of thirty (30) days until June 28, 2013**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a final request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court, today, May 29, 2013. The Court has granted four previous extensions, **however, this is undersigned counsel's first extension request in this case.**
2. This case was assigned to Breen Stevens, whose last day with the Appellate Division was Friday, May 24, 2013. Undersigned counsel is assuming Mr. Stevens' caseload effective yesterday, May 28, 2013, and has been reassigned to handle the present case. **A separate letter is being sent to this Court this week with a list of cases that undersigned counsel, Benjamin Tripp, is assuming.** Counsel is working on and plans to file the petitions for writ of certiorari and


accompanying appendices in the cases of Charles Gamble v. State and Howard Thompson v. State in the Supreme Court this week.

3. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.


