**PETITION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX**

The undersigned counsel respectfully requests a thirty-day extension in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in the above-referenced case. In support of this motion, counsel respectfully shows the Court the following exigent circumstances:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case are due to be served and filed today, having been extended by one prior order of this Court.

2. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Charvix. L. Wright in the Court of Appeals on October 10, 2022. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Tony O. Singleton in the Court of Appeals on October 5, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of State v. Travis Latrell Lawrence in this Court on


September 27, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Linda Monette in the Court of Appeals on September 21, 2022. Counsel presented on the topic of Do This, Not That! Ethical Responsibilities for Investigators on September 19, 2022, at the Public Defender Investigator Conference. Counsel attended the Annual Public Defender Conference from September 19-21, 2022. Counsel presented on the topic of Practical Ethics for the Criminal Defense Lawyer on September 21, 2022, at the Conference. Not only was counsel's attendance at the Conference necessary in light of her presentation, but it was necessary for counsel to obtain her required continuing legal education hours. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Anthony Anderson in the Court of Appeals on September 14, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Nicholas Benjamin Chhith-Berry in the Court of Appeals on September 12, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Joseph Lamar Brown, Jr. in the Court of Appeals on September 12, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Gregory Sanders in this Court on September 1, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Michael Barclay in the Court of Appeals on August 24, 2022.

3. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


