Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and the Record on Appeal in the case of James Charlie Hawkins v. The State with the Court of Appeals on September 26, 2022. Counsel attended the Annual South Carolina Public Defender Conference from September 19-21, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Jamacia Simon v. The State with this Court on September 9, 2022. Counsel appeared via WebEx at the Horry County Court to provide testimony in the Post-Conviction Relief Hearing in the case of Brian Spears v. The State on September 6, 2022. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Donald V. Stevenson v. The State in this Court on September 7, 2022.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


