DEFENDANT/APPELLANT'S TIMELY MOTIONS FOR THE CLERK OF THIS COURT TO CORRECT AND SUPPLEMENT THE PUBLIC DISPLAY OF C-TRACK OF THIS CASE AND OTHERS

For cause unknown to *pro se* Defendant-Appellant Marie Assa'ad-Faltas, MD, MPH's ("Dr. Assa'ad-Faltas" or "Dr. Faltas"), the *provisional* supplement to her petition for rehearing, hand-delivered to this Court's building and there and then stamped "received," all on 11 October 2022 (the deadline allowed by this Court's 26 September 2022 ORDER since no ruling on Dr. Faltas' motion for an extension issued) is entered as 12 October 2022. Also, Exhibits 19 and 20 to that *provisional* supplement are not uploaded to C-Track *at all*. Since Exhibit 19 is an order of this Court, and Exhibit 20 is a print-out of C-Track *of this case* as it appeared on 8 October 2022, neither exhibit can possibly be scandalous, objectionable, or otherwise subject to being peremptorily stricken by the Clerk.


Additionally, the one-page timely *provisional* supplement in SC Appellate Case 2022-000049, also hand-delivered and stamped received on 11 October 2022, is not uploaded on C-Track *at all*.

Without criticizing this Court's staff, Dr. Assa'ad-Faltas cannot accept that these errors happen because she has many cases. **She has many cases solely because many pre-known false criminal charges were brought against her with this Court's blessing or, at best, due to this Court's failure to enforce the safeguards against the bringing of false criminal charges *ab initio*.**

Even if the all three convictions underlying SC Appellate Cases 2021-000047, 48, and 49, were, God forbid, to *ultimately* stand, Dr. Assa'ad-Faltas has had favorable termination **of ten other criminal prosecutions of her**, in the most serious two of which a warrant would not even have issued but for the shocking ignorance of the City of Columbia Ministerial Recorder Angela Ladson; *vide* her 24 February 2010 *in camera* testimony previously submitted to this Court and others to no avail.

WHEREFORE, these errors should be corrected and some means less burdensome on Dr. Assa'ad-Faltas than travel to this Court's location with printed papers should be allowed to alert this Court's staff to their own errors without subjecting Dr. Assa'ad-Faltas to further incarceration.
