ORDER

Appellant filed a motion seeking an order setting aside her convictions, or in the alternative, remanding for a reconstruction hearing. In the motion, Appellant asserted that the Office of Court Administration did not have sufficient records from the court reporter to produce a transcript. The State filed a return and claimed that the court reporter may have additional records that would allow for transcription of the record at trial. After consulting with the Office of Court Administration in light of the State's assertions in its return, this Court has learned that the Office of Court Administration believes the court reporter is working on the transcript in this appeal. Accordingly, Appellant's motion is denied at this time. We direct counsel for the Appellant to contact the Office of Court Administration regarding the progress of the transcription and update the Court in thirty days from the date of this order.
