MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO  
SERVE AND FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI  
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Christopher A. Wylie respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Christopher A. Wylie respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the


number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel filed the brief of petition in the case of Carmie Josette Nelson v. State with the Supreme Court on October 7, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Tamika M. Scott v. State with the Supreme Court on October 6, 2022. From September 19, 2022 through September 21, 2022, counsel attended the Annual Public Defender Conference in Myrtle Beach. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Robert Justin Hord v. The State with the Supreme Court on August 26, 2022. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Anthony McClain v. The State with the Supreme Court on August 12, 2022. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Christopher Johnson v. The State with the Supreme Court on July 27, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Rickey Tate with the Supreme Court on July 25, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Kevin Casey v. The State with the Supreme Court on July 11, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of David Glover v. The State with the Supreme Court on July 8, 2022. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant, designation of matter, and record on appeal in the case of The State v. Brandy Harris with the Court of Appeals on July 1, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty-day extension, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for serving and filing the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
