Notice of Appeal

I William T Watts II am giving notice of my appeal to the Supreme Court of South Carolina. I am appealing the order to dismiss my appeal of the competency hearing, appellate case 2013-000177. The order to dismiss is based on State v. Miller, 289 S.C. 426, 426, 346 S.E. 2d 705, 705 (1986) ("In South Carolina a criminal defendant may not appeal until sentence has been imposed."); State v. Dingle, 279 S.C. 278, 282, 306 S.E. 2d 223, 225 (1983) (holding the pretrial commitment of a person the custody of the South Carolina Department of Mental Health for evaluation is not immediately appealable) The South Carolina Court of Appeals seems to be stating that the circuit court (Judge Newman and Clerk of Court), my lawyer (Elizabeth Fullwood) can deprive me of due process and constitutional rights during the hearing and it can not be appealed, That is not true, I can appeal to insure that due process and my constitutional rights are vindicated. I am being attacked by Lexington County Sheriff's Department (LCSO)

using a drone (remote-controlled plane) to x-ray me more than 50,000 times. These activities cause me to experience physical illnesses, pain and anguish. CCSD was using the drone during the hearing, I was being attacked and searched in court, I have attempted to file a lawsuit (case# 2013-000270) and motions to remove my ineffective lawyer, subpoena evidence and request a fast and speedy trial (case# 2012-213650) in Lexington County but the Clerk of Court has refused to file them (the only thing Lexington County has filed was my notice of appeal and I believe that was done to make it seem as if Lexington County was filing everything, they are not.) The only chance I have had to speak or file anything was at the hearing and I was not allowed to complete my sentences or thoughts. Now that the Court of Appeals will not allow my appeal, I have been completely cut off from any form of due process and hope of stopping CCSD's use of the drone and beginning to gather evidence and from protecting myself. Trying to defend myself from the police, solicitor, my lawyer and Judge is too much of a burden. I would like to be heard in court and get the evidence to support my claims. I am asking for a cease and desist order to stop CCSD's use of the drone.

My allegations stated in Federal civil case 8:12-cv-02909-TMC passed the test that my "complaint must contain sufficient factual matter, accepted as true, to state a claim that is plausible on its face". I am not delusional. (This case is mostly about LCSD using the drone and a variety of devices to harass me, kill me or jail me until I die of cancer. The case is similar to the case 2013-000270 except the case I filed with the Supreme Court of SC has more detail.)

I hope I have preserved all of my previous objections and appeal, including everything contained in case 2012-213650, 2013-000270 and 2013-000177.

Please overturn the decision of not competent, allow me to file my motions, lawsuit and present my case. Please stop LCSD's use of the drone.

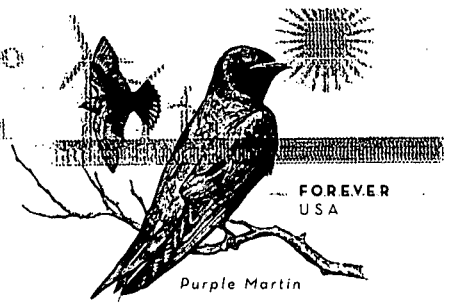

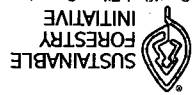
