MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Tyrone Maurice Moore, A/K/A Tyrone Moore respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from October 31, 2022 until November 30, 2022**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Tyrone Maurice Moore, A/K/A Tyrone Moore respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel is working on the brief of petitioner in the death penalty case of Marion Alexander Lindsey v. The State, along with co-counsel. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Sylvester Ferguson III, with the Supreme Court on October 12, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Allen Stone v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 10, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Chase Michael Milam with the Court of Appeals on October 3, 2022. Counsel attended the Annual Public Defender Conference, in North Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, on September 19-21, 2022. Counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Corey Jermaine Brown before the Supreme Court on September 14, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Jacob Ryan Aljoe with the Court of Appeals on August 26, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Phillip Richard Knighton with the Court of Appeals on August 23, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Correy Tremayne Brown with the Court of Appeals on August 17, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




