I don't entirely know how everything works but I forgot to include the relief that I am seeking, if this court allows - after review of the petition I submitted. The relief sought is for my sentence to be reduced to either ① time served or ② I have two charges run consecutively; A.B.HAM. 10 yrs & poss. of a weapon during the commission of a violent crime 5 yrs - I request they be run concurrently

I just want my sentence to be what I was understanding it would be when I plead guilty & such relief I just mentioned would be relatively consistent with what I thought I was pleading to. - I filed a P.C.R. two to three months after my trial & it took a couple years for a decision & then I appealed that & it took four plus years for a standard denial letter - Six years it has taken for me to get

to this point. I believe in my appeal. My trial turned plea counsel misinformed me & failed to inform me.

I am not a career criminal. I got into a fight with a guy who was drunk, in front of my home. He got hurt, I called for 911. I should of never been charged with attempted murder there has never been any evidence of intent - none. I am a veteran who trained hard & served proud. My whole family is in or has been in the military. I never knew about Veterans treatment courts or any such. This has been so hard on me & my family. I was sent to Broad River for the first six years of my sentence & it was a jungle - it was a war-zone & ~~probably~~ has been hell, only just recently I learned about an all veterans dorm at MacDonnell Correctional where I am now & it is very safe here & I appreciate the environment so much. My alleged victim said in court he had moved on & was over the instance of which I appeal. it took almost three years to get a trial. I am just ready for this all to be over with. If my sentence could just be fixed in the ways I requested here in this notice we wouldn't have to waste the states money, the time & emotions of me & my family and him & his family. 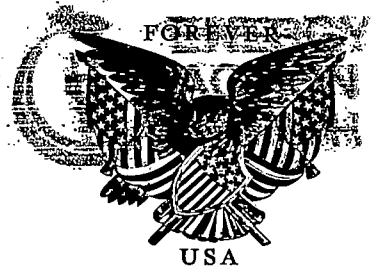

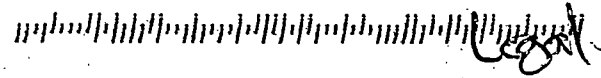
