## ORDER

---

After careful consideration, Respondent's requests to strike Appellant's final brief and to dismiss this appeal are denied. However, Respondent's request to strike the portions of Appellant's final brief that are different from Appellant's initial brief is granted. Specifically, Appellant added citations that did not appear in Appellant's initial brief. Rule 211(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court rules provides that the final briefs shall be identical to the initial brief except for (1) the correction of typographical errors and misspellings and (2) the revision of references in the initial brief to indicate where the material appears in the record on appeal. The rule does not provide for the addition of new citations to the record on appeal. Appellant shall serve and file an amended final brief within ten days. Respondent's final brief shall be due ten days thereafter.
