Undersigned counsel respectfully requests an order from this Court requiring the court reporter, Michael C. Watkins, to conform the transcript to the requirements stated in 607(c), SCACR that a transcript be “prepared in the manner prescribed by the Court Reporter Manual published by the Office of Court Administration.” In reviewing the record, counsel realized there are no time indications included for any jury actions. As set forth in Court Reporter Manual, the “court reporter is required to enter the following in parenthetical form: the times the jury enters and exits the courtroom for any reason, begins deliberations, and returns the verdict.” S.C. Ct. Administration, *Ct. Rep. Manual* at 34, <https://www.sccourts.org/courtreporter/CourtReporterManual.pdf>. Therefore, counsel respectfully requests an order requiring production of a properly transcribed transcript.

Furthermore, counsel requests the case be held in abeyance pending receipt of the transcript. This information is directly relevant to the issues counsel intends to raise on appeal; therefore, the deficiency impairs counsel’s ability to discuss and brief the appeal.
