Dear Mr. Cabbagestalk:

Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal may be dismissed:

- The caption/title page does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption should include the name of the Administrative Law Court judge, the title of the case, the title of the document, and the name and address of the party submitting the document. No other information should be on the title page.
- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The document has not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.

- The initial brief does not follow the format as set out by Rule 208(b), SCACR.
