3. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Derek Maner v. The State with



Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of Jonathan W. Duncan v. The State with this Court on October 13, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of The State v. Byron Labron Rivers with the Supreme Court on October 7, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Antwan Jamal Jett v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 29, 2022. Counsel filed the reply to return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Kayla Moore v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 28, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Demetrius Thompson with this Court on September 26, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Francisco Rodriguez v. The State with this Court on September 21, 2022.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.






