2. On November 10, 2022, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Shawn Torlif Daily with the Court of Appeals. On November 9, 2022, counsel filed the brief of respondent in The State v. Montrelle


Lamont Campbell with the Supreme Court. On November 3, 2022, counsel, along with co-counsel, filed the brief of petitioner in Marion Alexander Lindsey v. The State with the Supreme Court. On October 19, 2022, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Sebastian Dominic Kaisk with the Court of Appeals. On October 5, 2022, counsel filed the brief of petitioner in The State v. Stacardo Grissett with the Supreme Court. On September 28, 2022, counsel filed the brief of petitioner in Michael Orlando Brown v. The State with the Court of Appeals. On September 28, 2022, counsel filed the brief of petitioner in Keith Denver Tate v. The State with the Court of Appeals. From September 19, 2022 through September 21, 2022, counsel attended the Annual Public Defender Conference in Myrtle Beach. On September 15, 2022, counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Nyquan Brown before the Court of Appeals. On September 14, 2022, counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Russell Levon Johnson before the Supreme Court. . On September 7, 2022, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Paulette Sims with the Court of Appeals. On August 30, 2022, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Scott Welch v. The State with the Supreme Court.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




