MACK ADVISED THAT HER GRANDMOTHER RECENTLY PASSED AND WAS NOTIFIED TO VACATE THE APARTMENT. MACK LEFT ON 01/25/2022 AND RETURNED ON THURSDAY, 01/27/2022, TO RETRIEVE A PAIR OF SHOES. NOTHING WAS NOTICED ON THIS VISIT TO INDICATE A BREAK IN. MACK RETURNED AGAIN ON 01/28/2022 AND FOUND THAT THE APARTMENT WAS UNLOCKED. UPON FURTHER INSPECTION, MACK FOUND THAT FIVE NECKLACES AND TWO EARRING SETS (EST. \$2000 VALUE) AS WELL AS AN AIR FRYER (EST. \$60 VALUE) WERE MISSING. THERE WERE NO SIGNS OF FORCED ENTRY.

MACK STATED SHE FIRST ATTEMPTED TO REVIEW PLAYBACK VIDEO WITH THE PROPERTY MANAGER BUT WAS DENIED. I COMPLETED A VICTIMS FORM AND THIS ENCOUNTER WAS RECORDED ON MY BWC.

Important Information and Numbers for Crime Victims

South Carolina Crime Victims' Constitutional Rights

To preserve and protect victims' rights to justice and due process regardless of race, sex, age, religion, economic status, victims of crime have the right to:

1. be treated with fairness, respect, and dignity, and to be free from intimidation, harassment, or abuse, throughout the criminal and juvenile justice process, and informed of the victim's constitutional rights, provided by statute;
2. be reasonably informed when the accused or convicted person is arrested, released from custody, or has escaped;
3. be informed of and present at any criminal proceedings which are dispositive of the charges where the defendant has the right to be present;
4. be reasonably informed of and be allowed to submit either a written or oral statement at all hearings affecting bond or bail;
5. be heard at any proceeding involving a post-arrest release decision, a plea, or sentencing;
6. be reasonably protected from the accused or persons acting on his behalf throughout the criminal justice process;
7. confer with the prosecution, after the crime against the victim has been charged, before the trial or before any disposition and informed of the disposition;
8. have reasonable access after the conclusion of the criminal investigation to all documents relating to the crime against the victim before trial;
9. receive prompt and full restitution from the person or persons convicted of the criminal conduct that caused the victim's loss or injury including both adult and juvenile offenders;
10. be informed of any proceeding when any post-conviction action is being considered, and be present at any post-conviction hearing involving a post-conviction release decision;
11. a reasonable disposition and prompt and final conclusion of the case;
12. have all rules governing criminal procedure and the admissibility of evidence in all criminal proceedings protect victims' rights and have these rules subject to amendment or repeal by the legislature to ensure protection of these rights.

The eligibility requirements to receive victim's compensation benefits

- The victim must have been directly injured, physically or emotionally.
- The victim must not have initiated, provoked, caused, or contributed to the incident.
- The victim must not have been engaged in any illegal activity at the time of the incident.
- The victim must cooperate with law enforcement and the Department of Crime Victim Compensation.
- The crime must have been reported to law enforcement within 48 hours.
- The claim must have been filed within 180 days from the date of the incident or the discovery of crime and the crime must not have occurred more than four years ago.

If you are being harassed or threatened

In South Carolina, there are **Orders of Protection** from domestic violence and **Restraining Orders** against harassment and stalking. Both are court orders that are intended to protect you from the suspect.

- **Order of Protection** are granted by Family Court or Magistrate's Court that can protect you from an abuser that is a spouse, ex-spouse, someone you have a child in common, or anyone who are living together or have cohabitated. *The Pee Dee Coalition Against Domestic & Sexual Assault* (220 S. Irby Street, Florence, 29501) provides assistance and guidance to domestic victims. There is no charge for this order.
- **Restraining Orders** are granted by a Magistrate's Court. This action must be filed in the county, in which the suspect resides, and there must have been 2 incidents of harassment or stalking that occurred within the last 90 days.

A violation of either an Order of Protection or a Restraining Order is a criminal offense and the suspect could be arrested.

MACK'S VEHICLE IS A GREY 2006 CHEVY IMPALA WITH SC TAG 6564LY. BWC USED. NO FURTHER INFORMATION IS AVAILABLE AT THIS TIME.
