Minimum Terms of Imprisonment  
Section 1. Section 16-1-20 (B) of  
the 1976 Code as last amended by  
act 184 of 1993 is further amended  
to read:

LL S.C. ST. 16-1-20

(B) For all offenders sentenced on or after  
July 1, 1993, THE minimum term of  
imprisonment required by law does not  
apply to the offenses listed in sections
