Motion to for Extension of Time

---

Appellants hereby move pursuant to Rule 263(b) SCACR for a 30-day extension of the time in which to serve and file their Initial Brief and Designation of Matter. The grounds for this motion are that there is good cause to grant the requested extension, as follows:

1. Appellants' initial brief and designation of matter are due Monday, November 7,

2022. If this request for an extension is granted, this initial brief and designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal will be due on December 6, 2022.

2. This is the First Extension of Time sought by the appellants.
3. This case was dismissed by *sua sponte* order of the Court prior to the filing of the Initial Brief. The case was reinstated by an order Dated October 6, 2022. The order did not state when the Appellant's Initial Brief would be due, but it is presumed to be 30 days from that order.
4. The undersigned counsel is requesting an additional 30 days to draft and file the initial brief due to multiple court appearances and a busy schedule.
5. Appellant believes there is good cause to grant this extension and this is the first such extension requested.
