By way of an Order dated March 9, 2021, this Court granted Petitioner's motion to remand. In accordance with the directives in the Order, I have contacted witnesses, the PCR judge, and opposing counsel. I have also met with my client, who is now back at CoreCivic in Mississippi; I have confirmed that facility has web conferencing capabilities for an upcoming reconstruction hearing via WebEx. I requested and received notes from the state's attorney from the original PCR hearing. I will continue to take steps to streamline the reconstruction process.

On July 12, 2022, opposing counsel and I met virtually with Judge Jefferson for a status conference. We discussed the list of potential witnesses, the judge's notes from the PCR hearing, and timing and logistics. Earlier this month, Judge Jefferson reached out to counsel about the number of witnesses for a hearing.
