Dear Mr. Crawford:

Upon reviewing your appellant's final brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, your proof of service states that you served the "Respondent's Final Brief" on the Respondent.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, your name and address must be on the cover page of the final brief instead of the counsel for respondent.
- The document is not accompanied by the certificate of counsel required by Rule 211, SCACR.
- The record on appeal has not been timely served and filed as required by Rule 210, SCACR. You must serve and file the record on appeal, including one electronic or unbound copy as well as one bound copy.
