Dear Ms. Howard:

In review of the Brief of Respondent filed by Ms. Lara Caudy in this matter it came to my attention by Footnote 1 that there was an inaccuracy set forth in a portion of Petitioner's Statement of Facts (Brief of Petitioner, p. 5) concerning the description of the multiple camera angles of video surveillance. I had the opportunity yesterday to reexamine the videos in question and have independently verified that the inaccuracy is present and should be corrected. Concerning the inaccuracy, the "man dressed in blue" cannot be *viewed by surveillance pulling up to Nunan street, and both leaving and returning from that area while carrying the assault rifle*. However, in the later footage the man dressed in blue is clearly visible and carrying an assault rifle while walking down President Street and onto Nunan Street where the car was parked. My apologies for the misconception and inartful wording.

If I may impose upon you, please attach this letter to the Brief of Petitioner so as to alert the Court to the oversight. I also intend on addressing in more detail and clarity the video footage in question in the State's Reply to the Brief of Respondent, to ensure the Court has a thorough and accurate summation of the video evidence.
