APPELLANT’S MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME


Appellant PruittHealth-Ridgeway, LLC (“Appellant”) moves this Honorable Court for an extension of time within which to prepare Appellant’s Reply Brief. This is Appellant’s first motion for an extension of time. In support of its Motion, Appellant submits:

1. On May 2, 2022, Appellant timely filed and served its Notice of Appeal.
2. On August 5, 2022, Appellant timely filed and served its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter.

3. On September 14, 2022, this Honorable Court granted Respondent's first motion for an extension of time to file its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to October 19, 2022.
4. On October 11, 2022, this Honorable Court granted Respondent's second motion for an extension of time to file its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to November 18, 2022.


