APPEAL CASE # 2022-0000775 PET HELPERS, INC. v JANET L. FRISCO v MELISSA SUSKO, THIRD-PARTY DEFENDANT

Dear Ms. Kitchings,

I thought my extension was November 16, 2022, but I was just filing my Initial Brief and Designation of Matter in the binder and noticed the date of the deadline was actually November 14, 2022. I don't know why I was confused, but I truly thought I had until Wednesday, November 16th to file the documents. I'm writing this letter to ask for leniency in my error for several reasons which I will elaborate on here.

I'm trying to fulfill the duties of my forty-hour a week job and my other personal duties entirely by myself because I'm a widow and don't have anyone else to help me with those responsibilities. I'm in failing health because of the demands and stress of the lawsuit Pet Helpers, Inc.

implemented against me that began on June 9, 2021. My free time is totally consumed with defending myself against their false accusation of libel and slander and I don't have time for recreation, exercise or seeing my doctors. I'm sixty-eight years old and it's difficult to keep everything organized because my life has become extremely difficult due to the lawsuit and other matters I'm currently involved in.

Lastly, there was a drive-by shooting that targeted the home next to me on October 18, 2022 which I am also dealing with because the Dorchester County Sheriff's Department and other law enforcement agencies are assisting a drug dealer next door to operate his illegal business and persecuted me because I reported him for animal neglect in April 2021. The courts granted him a restraining order against me when I reported his animal abuse. His name is Antonio B. Harris and he has an Order of Forfeiture after he was arrested for possession of a controlled substance on September 7, 2016. I made a voluntary statement at the Dorchester County Sheriff's Office the day after the shooting and am working with the press to expose the organized crime that is also active here in Dorchester County.

I'm experiencing these difficulties because I am the type of citizen who doesn't look the other way when I encounter violations of the laws which should be the norm for all citizens, but I assume they are very intimidated when they realize they could face repercussions from the false authorities if they say anything. Just as I am exposing Pet Helpers, Inc. for their fraud in the fake adoption of my dog, Toby, I am also exposing Dorchester County government for assisting criminals and penalizing people like me who report and expose illegal activities. The Dorchester County Magistrate Court and Sheriff's Department's Victim's Advocate Office and other law enforcement agencies were involved in helping Mr. Harris retaliate against me for reporting the neglect of his dog. He was never punished in any way after his arrest on September 7, 2016 and has committed other crimes in the past which he has not been held accountable for. Dorchester County Building Code Enforcement issued him a permit for a "sun barrier" after he built a "blind" between our two properties. When I sought reimbursement for

the landscaping costs I incurred while trying to hide the blind he erected, the magistrate court ruled in his favor. He has the support of all law enforcement agencies and the courts to break the laws of the state.

Thank you for your understanding of these complicated and threatening matters I am dealing with at this time as a result of my courage to oppose crime and the powerful forces behind it.
