Dear Ms. Allen:

I request a second extension of time in which to file the Initial Appellants' Reply Brief and reply designation.

The earlier 10-day extension would expire November 17. The additional 10-day extension would place the papers due Monday, November 28, 2022.

The workload in my office, coupled with a pre-planned trip recently completed, necessitate the extension. In addition to usual matters, I had two litigation matters need accelerated attention and several long-term transactional matters unexpectedly became urgent a week or more ago and I had the prior years' working knowledge of the matters. I had a pre-planned trip with others just a few days ago, which involved long drives and a heavily laden hike (with musical instruments) to stay in a mountaintop location not accessible by car, around the time the remnants of Hurricane Nicole were passing the area and threatening dangerous amounts of precipitation. Our start was delayed and made more strenuous when we were re-routed on the front end to a longer, less common path with a 3993 foot elevation gain instead of 2400, and our return was complicated and ran later because of freezing conditions and about 12 hours of nonstop precipitation. On the heels of this, I have an M&A-type matter of significant size that is becoming very active with a new party.

In lieu of affidavit, I affirm these matters to the Court and am making this request by e-mail rather than motion, but please let me know if any more formal application is required.
