At a Court of General Sessions, convened on July 12, 2018 the Grand Jurors of
SUMTER County present upon their oath:

COUNT ONE

MURDER

That Alonzo Shaw did in Sumter County, on or about April 24, 2018, willfully, feloniously, and intentionally kill the victim, [REDACTED] with malice aforethought, either express or implied, by means of shooting, and the victim did die as a proximate result thereof on or about April 24, 2018 in Sumter County, in violation of Section 16-03-0010, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT TWO

CHILD NEGLECT

That on or about April 24, 2018, in Sumter, while having charge or custody, or being the parent or guardian, or being responsible for the welfare of the minor child, A.S., age one (1) year old, the Defendant, Alonzo Shaw, did place the child at unreasonable risk of harm affecting the child's life, physical or mental health, or safety; all in violation of Section 20-7-50, South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.


COUNT THREE

POSSESSION OF A WEAPON DURING THE COMMISSION OF A VIOLENT CRIME
