**MOTION FOR THIRD EXTENSION TO FILE
RETURN TO PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI**

COMES NOW, Respondent, by and through the undersigned counsel, making its motion for an additional thirty (30) day extension of time to file the return to petition for writ of certiorari, up to and including December 23, 2022. This is Respondent's third request for an extension of time in which to file the return. In support of this request, undersigned counsel would respectfully show unto this Court¹:


1. The return to petition for writ of certiorari is due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.


2. This is the third request for an extension of time in which to file the return.
3. Counsel has assumed and maintained double the workload with very limited assistance since February 21, 2022.
4. Counsel appeared on behalf of the State at a PCR term in Spartanburg County the weeks of August 8-12, 2022, and October 17- 21, 2022, and is currently drafting orders for the cases heard during this term.
5. Counsel became ill with the coronavirus on August 14, 2022, and did not return to the office to work until August 30, 2022.
6. Counsel appeared on behalf of the State at a PCR term in the Fifteenth Circuit the week of September 5-9, 2022, and is currently drafting orders for the cases heard during this term.
7. Counsel had an out of term hearing in Chesterfield County and Georgetown County on September 1, 2022, and an additional out of term hearing in Spartanburg September 19-20, 2022.
8. Counsel had surgery on September 30, 2022, and did not return to the office to work until October 6, 2022.

In short, this extension request is not intended for purposes of delay, but rather to ensure that the return is properly researched and prepared. The undersigned is currently working on the return and hopes to have it completed shortly. The undersigned therefore requests an extension of time within which to serve and file the return. THEREFORE, undersigned counsel for Respondent respectfully requests a **third thirty-day extension**, in which to complete and file the return to petition for writ of certiorari in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel for Petitioner has consented to this extension request through reciprocal agreement between our respective offices.
