Dear Ms. Allen:

The workload in my office, coupled with a pre-planned trip recently completed, necessitate the extension. In addition to usual matters, I had two litigation matters need accelerated attention and several long-term transactional matters unexpectedly became urgent a week or more ago and I had the prior years' working knowledge of the matters.
