

AMENDED
NOTICE OF APPEAL

Joseph Mickle appeals the decision of the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission's Appellate Panel dated May 14, 2013. Appellant received a copy of this decision on May 14, 2013. Appellant asserts that the Commission's Appellate Panel erred as a matter of law and fact in affirming that portion of the Hearing Commissioner's Order which included an erroneous credit to Defendants for having paid 136 weeks of temporary total disability benefits where this mistaken credit resulted from a typographical error and where Defendants had actually paid and were entitled to a credit for only 32 weeks of temporary total disability benefits. The Appellate Panel erred as a matter of law in affirming the mistaken credit and in failing to correct the credit and award calculations according to the evidence submitted.
