Good morning,

Per the Supreme Court of South Carolina's Order on April 6, 2022 assigning Judge Hood to the above matter, Judge Hood is to provide the Court with a status update every 120 days. Please accept the following as a status update in accordance with the Court's Order.

A status conference for this matter was held on July 28th, 2022 via WebEx. The State filed a Return to the Post-Conviction Relief Application filed by Gary Terry and submitted on March 21, 2022. Respondent submitted its Return, as well as a Motion to Dismiss, on April 28, 2022. A hearing on this Motion to Dismiss was held in Fairfield County on November 30, 2022. The Applicant was present in this hearing along with his attorneys Charles Grose and Hannah Freedman. Ed Salter and Melody Brown of the Attorney General's Office were also present representing the State. Upon hearing the arguments by Counsel in support and opposition of this Motion, the Court took this matter under advisement. A status conference was scheduled for December 2, 2022, but the Court confirmed with all parties that the conference was no longer necessary due to the hearing on November 30.
