Upon reviewing your cross appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your cross appeal will be dismissed:

- You must also show proof of filing your notice of appeal with the circuit court clerk pursuant to Rule 203(d)(1)(B), SCACR.
