ORDER

Petitioner has failed to provide a sufficient explanation as required by Rule 243(c), SCACR, showing there is an arguable basis for asserting the determination by the lower court was improper. Accordingly, we dismiss the notice of appeal in this matter. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.

Further, we hereby prohibit Petitioner from filing any further collateral actions in the circuit court, including post-conviction relief (PCR) actions and habeas corpus actions, as well as any motions relating to previously filed collateral actions, challenging his 1995 convictions and sentences or any motions in the underlying criminal case, including motions pursuant to Rule 29, SCRCrimP, without first obtaining permission to do so from this Court.
