MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

2. Counsel for Christopher Jamel Brisbon respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time.

On November 22, 2022, counsel presented on the topic of Ethics of a Public Defender at the Public Defense 101: Fundamentals of the Profession Conference. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of State v. Robert Lee Miller, III in the Supreme Court on November 21, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Nicholas Benjamin Chhith-Berry in the Supreme Court on November 17, 2022. Counsel filed the brief of respondent in the case of James L. Carrier v. State in this Court on November 15, 2022. Counsel filed the initial reply brief of appellant in the case of State v. Denzell Deshawn Jackson in this Court on November 14, 2022. Counsel attended a PCR hearing at the Berkeley County Courthouse in the case of State v. Emory Warren Roberts on November 2, 2022. Counsel filed the reply to return to petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Gregory Sanders in the Supreme Court on October 24, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Kyle Maurice Robinson in the Supreme Court on October 20, 2022. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Charvix. L. Wright in this Court on October 10, 2022. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Tony O. Singleton in this Court on October 5, 2022.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. On November 29, 2022, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by
