After careful consideration, Respondent's motion to dismiss is denied. Respondent failed to demonstrate that all of the documents at issue have been made public; therefore, there remains a "real and substantial controversy which is appropriate for judicial determination." *Sloan v. Friends of Hunley, Inc.*, 369 S.C. 20, 25, 630 S.E.2d 474, 477 (2006) (finding FOIA action was moot where the respondents disclosed *all* of the requested documents).
