ORDER

This appeal arises out of an order of the Single Commissioner of the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission dismissing Appellant's petition for hearing. Because a final order has not been issued by the Commission, this appeal is dismissed. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-380 (Supp. 2021) (“A party who has exhausted all administrative remedies available within the agency and who is aggrieved by a final decision in a contested case is entitled to judicial review pursuant to this article....”); *Janhrette v. Union Camp Paper Corp.*, 293 S.C. 59, 59–60, 358 S.E.2d 704, 705 (1987) (holding a single commissioner’s decision cannot be directly appealed to the circuit court without first being reviewed by the full commission). The remittitur will be sent as provided in Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
