MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for appellant respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from December 19, 2022, until January 18, 2023**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for appellant respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions


previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Jarret Graddick v. State with the Court of Appeals on December 12, 2022. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of William Bruce Justice v. State with the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals on December 6, 2022. Counsel appeared before the Court of Appeals for Oral Argument in the case of Mitchell Rivers v. State on December 6, 2022. Counsel presented at Public Defense 101: Fundamentals of the Profession on November 21, 2022. Counsel attended the Appellate Advocacy Workshop: Oral Argument seminar on November 19, 2022. Counsel appeared before the Court of Appeals for Oral Argument in the case of Charles Green v. State on November 16, 2022. Counsel filed the *Johnson* petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Brandon Adams v. State with the Supreme Court on November 10, 2022. Counsel testified as a witness in the PCR Hearing held in the Berkeley County Court of Common Pleas via WebEx in the case of Jeffrey L. Whitsett v. The State on November 1, 2022. Counsel appeared before the Court of Appeals for Oral Argument in the case of Mack Washington v. The State on October 12, 2022. Counsel presented for a CLE on the topic of Emojis in the Law sponsored by the Trial and Appellate Advocacy Section of the South Carolina Bar on October 11, 2022.




