**MOTION FOR 10 DAY EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE

Appellant respectfully moves this Honorable Court for an order allowing him a ten (10) day extension to serve his Final Brief pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR. This motion is made on the grounds that Appellant previously scheduled extensive holiday travel out of state for the month of December 2022. Additionally, counsel for Respondent has had a 19-day extension ordered by this court, and fairness dictates that a similar extension be available to Appellant. A supplement to the Record on Appeal (ROA) is requested to be included in this order to allow appending this Final Brief and a Clerk of Court requested Update to Appellant’s Initial Brief, which had been conformed to caption and single spacing of Standard Form 13, requiring revision to caption and double spacing of Rule 267 SCRAP. Extensive review is required for Final Brief ROA references, which will benefit expediting review by the Board. Appellant also has a disability condition from a heart failure condition he must accommodate, possibly related
