This matter came before the Court for a hearing on December 5, 2022, pursuant to the Plaintiffs' Motion for Emergency Mandatory Injunctive Relief filed on December 2, 2022 (the Motion). Defendant/Counter-Plaintiff Maddox Industrial Transformer, LLC (MIT) filed a memorandum in opposition to the Motion prior to the hearing on December 5, 2022. After hearing oral arguments from counsel, the Court **GRANTS IN PART** the Motion and hereby orders as follows:

1. Plaintiffs shall post bond equal to the distributions required herein. After such bond is posted and MIT's counsel is notified of same, MIT shall timely disburse \$1,713,057.60 to Plaintiff Randall P. Maddox, individually and as Trustee of the Randall P. Maddox 2007 Trust and \$924,878.36 to Plaintiff Marvin H. Blundell, individually and as Trustee of the Marvin H. Blundell Revocable Trust.

2. The Court does not make any findings of fact or conclusions of law concerning liability for the distributions of tax payments at issue. Furthermore, this ruling shall not apply to any future obligations for distribution of tax payments by MIT.

3. If it is ultimately determined that Plaintiffs are not entitled to any part of such distributions, Plaintiffs shall repay the distributions to MIT, plus interest at the prevailing legal rate(s) set by the South Carolina Supreme Court, within 30 days.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
